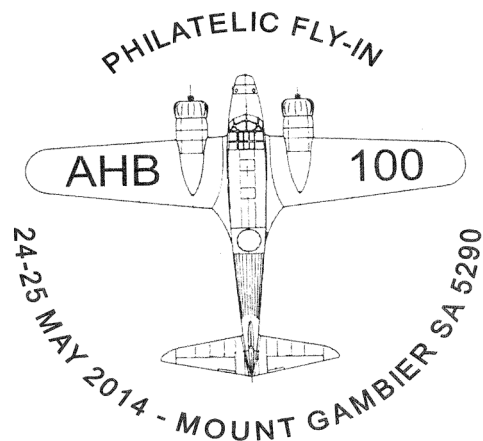


Mt Gambier Weekend 24-25 May 2014

Over the weekend there will be meetings of the Australian Cover Society (Saturday am), Australian Air Mail Society (Saturday pm), South Australia Study Group (Sunday am) and a seminar on philatelic exhibiting (Sunday pm). The meetings will be informal with various displays presented by members of both the visiting society and the Mount Gambier P.S. A number of philatelic and picture post-card traders will also be in attendance on both days. The Philatelic Fly-in will be at the Reidy Park Community Centre, O'Halloran Terrace, Mount Gambier from 10am to 5pm on both days. A dinner is being arranged for the Saturday night at one of the local hotels.

Australia Post are providing a pictorial postmark for the event and will be in attendance on the Saturday morning to cancel souvenir covers, including those being carried on the commemorative air mail from Adelaide on May 24th. The postmark features an Avro Anson aircraft as used at the Mount Gambier RAAF Base in World War II and flown by Arthur Bergen to train navigators and wireless operators. THE APF STORE

Whilst talking to a fellow collector the comment that the general club member is not aware of the existence of the APF Archival Store and what it does. This short article is an attempt to remedy this.

Basically the APF store exists to service the needs of collectors in displaying or exhibiting their material. This means it carries stocks of archival quality paper, protectors and photo corners to sell to collectors so they can display and store their collections safely. Because the APF sees the store as a service to collectors rather than a profit making business, mark ups are kept to a minimum thus making prices very competitive.

In addition the APF also sells specially produced philatelic items such as the very popular replica cards and over printed Rising Sun miniature sheet through the store.

Monies raised through such items are used to promote philately in Australia.

The APF store is located in Saphil House and is open on Monday and Thursday from 9 am – 3 pm. A complete list of all items (with prices) is available from the office at these times or from the APF website. Simply Google APF, go to the Australian Philatelic Federation website and then click on the Store tab. The website will explain how to order material you need or you can purchase directly from the store when it is open on Mondays and Thursdays.
